Final Instructions

These Final Instructions complement, and are in addition to, the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, and any other Supplementary Regulations that may or have been issued. Please read them carefully and comply accordingly:

Rider Numbers and Start Time. First man away 9.00am the rest at 1-minute intervals.

Your allocated rider numbers are shown on the Riders List. Numbers will be provided and so please ensure that any other form of numbering on your machine is removed

Camping

Anyone wishing to camp on the Saturday night (FOC) should follow signs to camping area.

Signing On

Sign on at the start, your riding number will be assigned to you. And any info regarding route changes.

Road Traffic Acts & Insurance is provided automatically.

Each rider is responsible for answering any legal action that may be taken against them in respect of any infringement of the Road Traffic Acts and other legislation,

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE YOU AND YOUR MOTORCYCLE COMPLIES WITH THE LAW.

Technical Inspection

There will be a Machine inspection at the start. **Any road legal tyre will be allowed in the event, non-road legal tyres, No start.**

Fuel

There is a fuel stop along the route, however YOU SHOULD ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE ENOUGH FUEL FOR AT LEAST 50 MILES before you set off and note that there is **NO** fuel available at the start.

Reading the Route Card and Arrows

Please ensure you are familiar with the route card and how it depicts where you should go. Each major box has a diagram showing you the direction you are travelling from – depicted by a black dot, and the direction you should travel in, shown by a black arrow. The distance between each instruction is shown in the central box at the top of each picture box and is integral to following the route. E.g., If it says 1.2 kms to the next turning, don't turn off after 400 yds!! At various places along the route will be confirmation arrows. These are plain orange this year. (There will not be as many this year so keep your eye on the road book.)

Inspection of Sections - You may look at the sections unless the observer deems it unnecessary.

Refreshments, there will be a food van at the start and end of event,

Assistance Telephone

There is an assistance telephone number, which, if possible, you should call if you are going to be late back to the start. E.g. if you have had a puncture or mechanical difficulty, had an accident, or got hopelessly lost and lost loads of time finding your way back onto the route.

Please make sure all gates are closed after you pass through.

Courtesy to the Public

There are a few sensitive areas around the course – which if we are not careful could mean we lose the right to use sections of the course. Please ALWAYS slowdown near houses, horses, walkers and through villages – making as little noise as possible. Be polite, say hello and thank people if they stop to allow you past. **Unfortunately, due to some last-minute lane closures by the local council, we have more road work than we would have liked, however this is on small minor roads.**

There will be further sections when you arrive at the finish.

Signing Off. Please sign off at the finish, this is important, we need to know that there is no one lost on the route. Even if you retire early.
